## CONFORMATION SHOW INFORMATION

### Classes Offered:

This is the 2009 USRC Northeast Regional Sieger Show & BST. Youth Sieger/Siegerin, Sieger/Siegerin and Select Male/Female titles will be awarded. USRC recognized working title and breed test is required to be named Sieger or Siegerin.

### Regular Classes

Puppy Classes: 4-6 Month Male/Female; 6-9 Month Male/Female; 9-12 Month Male/Female

Youth Classes: 12-18 Month Male/Female; 18-24 Month Male/Female

### Adult Classes:

Open Male/Female: For all Rottweilers 24 months and older without a Schutzhund or IPO title, a Championship or Sieger/Siegerin title. Need not be USRC registered to compete.

Champion Male/Female: For all Rottweilers 24 months and older that have earned an AKC, CKC, International FCI Championship and any champion of Record from a country whose Championship was awarded by an FCI recognized kennel club. Dogs entering the Champion class that are eligible to be awarded the USRC Sieger or Siegerin title must be USRC registered.

Working Male/Female: For all Rottweilers 24 months and older with a USRC recognized SchH/VPG/IPO title who have not earned a USRC Sieger or Siegerin title. Must be USRC registered.

Sieger/Siegerin Class: For all Rottweilers 24 months and older that have earned a Sieger or Siegerin title from a USRC National or Regional Show or have been awarded the USRC Universal Sieger or Siegerin title. Dogs eligible to enter the Sieger or Siegerin class may not enter the Open, Champion or Working class; however, the dog may enter the Veteran Class if the dog's age permits.

Veteran Male/Female: For all Rottweilers 7 years or older on the day of the show. Veteran class entries are not eligible for titles and receive only critiques, no ratings or placements.

Kennel Group: Entered by the Kennel owner. Three or more dogs bred by the Kennel Owner and registered with the Kennel Name of the entrant. The Kennel Owner need not be the registered owner of the dogs. All dogs must first be entered in the show's regular classes. Written critiques are not given.

Brood Bitch: Entered by the owner of the brood bitch. The brood bitch and at least two of her produce must appear in the ring. The bitch must have a USRC recognized Breed Test and have been at least 24 months of age at the time of breeding. The class is to be evaluated on the merits of the produce. The owner of the brood bitch need not be the owner of the produce. The produce must first be entered in the show's regular classes. Written critiques are not given.

Stud Dog: Entered by the owner of the stud dog. The stud dog and at least two of his get must appear in the ring. The dog must have a USRC recognized Breed Test and have been at least 24 months of age at the time of breeding. The class is to be evaluated on the merits of the get. The owner of the stud dog need not be the owner

## ADDITIONAL SHOW INFORMATION

Once a dog is eligible for the Champion, Working or Sieger/Siegerin class, the dog may not enter the Open Class. When a dog is eligible for more than one class, the dog's owner determines the entry. Photocopies of support documents for all titles and accomplishments must be sent with entry; original documents must be available for inspection at the show. A valid Hip Certification, pass or fail is required on all dogs over the age of 30 months.

This is a German style conformation show. The decision of the Körmeister is final. No dog shall be permitted to enter any class with missing teeth. Dogs born after 6/1/1999 in countries with docking laws must be shown with natural tail.

Dogs are shown in a natural stance; **no hand stacking is allowed**. Double handling is permitted; **no food is allowed in the ring**. Adult classes will be moved (run) long enough for the judge to evaluate dogs' movement and fitness. You may change handlers as needed. Event will be held outdoors, rain or shine. Bring your own chairs and anything else you may deem necessary for comfort for you and your dogs. No dogs may be tied out at show site or ringside. Please do not bring unentered dogs to the show grounds. Please use designated areas to exercise your dogs and clean up after them. Dress is informal.

## BREED SUITABILITY TEST INFORMATION

**Copies of the following documents must be submitted with BST entry.**

1. Copy of USRC Membership Card for both owner and handler.
2. Copy of USRC Registration for the dog being entered.
3. Copy of scorebook showing titles earned, scorebook number, and full name of dog. If the BH is earned after the close of entries, a copy of the scorebook showing the BH title must be presented to the BST secretary on the day of the Breed Test.
4. Copy of USRC recognized Hip Certification. All dogs must have their permanent identification indicated on their Hip Certification.
5. Copy of any prior BST attempts.
6. Copy of Weight Certificate dated within 30 days of the test date.
7. A copy of the USRC Registration Certificate may be accepted as proof of titles earned and hip certification if the required information appears on the Registration Certificate.

**The following ORIGINAL documents must be submitted to the BST Secretary on the day of the Breed Test. Entry into the BST will not be accepted without presenting these originals prior to taking the test.**

1. USRC Membership Card for both owner and handler. A copy of the Membership card will be accepted on the day of the show. This exception to the original document requirements applies to the membership cards only.
2. USRC Registration Certificate for the dog being entered.
3. Scorebook showing titles earned, (minimum BH) scorebook number and full name of dog.
4. USRC recognized Hip Certification. All dogs must have their permanent identification indicated on their Hip Certification.
5. Prior BST attempts.
6. Weight certificate dated within 30 days of the test date.
7. The USRC Registration Certificate may be accepted as proof of titles earned and hip certification if the required information appears on the Registration Certificate.

## PARTICIPANT/SPECTATOR CODE OF CONDUCT

The Southeastern PA Rottweiler Klub is committed to creating a fun and enjoyable atmosphere for all exhibitors and spectators, their guest and their dogs, in the show ring, on the trial field and on any grounds where a SPARK event is held. SPARK expects all who attend SPARK events to behave in a responsible fashion. When attending a SPARK event, you are required to refrain from the following behaviors:

- » Behavior that is unruly, disruptive, or illegal in nature.
- » Intoxication or other signs of alcohol impairment that results in irresponsible behavior.
- » Foul or abusive language or obscene gestures.
- » Interference with the progress of the event.
- » Failing to follow instructions of local club personnel that are hosting the show, their volunteers, local show site personnel, the USRC Regional Director and/or local officials.
- » Any verbal harassment of and including but not limited to; judges and their spouses or guests; other exhibitors, handlers, spectators, their families and guests; SPARK Officers and Directors, local club personnel, show site personnel or officials, show volunteers and show vendors.
- » Any physical assault and/or battery of and including but not limited to; judges and their spouses or guests; other exhibitors, spectators, their families and guests; SPARK Officers and Directors local club personnel, show site personnel or officials, show volunteers and show vendors.
- » Any physical abuse or battery of any animal by any participant, handler, exhibitor, owner, spectator or guest, show site personnel or officials, show volunteers and show vendors.
- » Any mishandling, deliberate or otherwise, of any animal that puts any person(s) at risk of physical harm, including but not limited to; exhibitors, handlers, spectators, their guests, local club personnel, show site personnel, show volunteers, vendors and local authorities.

All event participants, handlers and exhibitors are responsible for their conduct, the conduct of their guests and the conduct of their dogs or dogs that they may be handling for other parties. Event participants, handlers, exhibitors and spectators, including their guests, who violate the provisions of this code, may be subject to immediate and possible permanent ejection without refund and/or loss of participatory privileges in future SPARK sponsored events.

## DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE

From the Host Hotel:

**Approximate Distance: 23 MI / Approximate Driving Time:30 minutes**

Go East on PA-10 (Cherry St). Take I-76 (PA Turnpike) ramp on right (toll required for some segments. Take I-76 E (Philadelphia, Exits 32-39) ramp on left. Take Exit 312 (PA-100, Pottstown, West Chester) on right. Take Downingtown Interchange ramp (*toll required for some segments*). Take PA-100 South (Downingtown) ramp. Continue onto PA-100 (N Pottstown Pike) . Bear left onto PA-113 (E Uwchlan Av). Follow PA-113. Turn left at flashing traffic light (Firehouse Lane) and signs for show. There is a printing company (Rowlands) right across the street from Firehouse Lane.

From the East:

**From New Jersey:** PA Turnpike West to Exit 326 (Valley Forge). Go through toll plaza and take first exit on right (Valley Forge). Follow to Route 23 (approx 4 lights). Route 23 West through Valley Forge Park and Phoenixville. Left on Route 113 South (McDonalds on Right). Follow approximately 1.5 miles, Fairgrounds are on the right.

**From Philadelphia:** Schuylkill Expressway West to Valley Forge Exit 327 Mall Blvd. Turn Right on Mall Blvd. Go to stop light, turn Right on to Gulph Road. Follow to Route 23 (approx. 5 lights). Route 23 West through Valley Forge Park and Phoenixville. Left on Route 113 South (McDonalds on Right). Follow approximately 1.5 miles, Fairgrounds are on the right.

From the West:

**Harrisburg:** PA Turnpike East to Exit 312 (Downingtown). Route 100 South to Route 113 North. Cross Route 401. Continue to traffic light (5 miles) at Coldstreams Road. Continue on Route 113, Fairgrounds entrance 1/4 mile on Left.

**Reading:** Route 422 East to Route 724 (past Pottstown). Turn Left off exit ramp onto Route 724. Follow Route 724 till it ends and becomes Route 23. Follow Route 23 East to Route 113 South (McDonalds on Left). Turn Right onto Route 113, follow approximately 1.5 miles, Fairgrounds are on the right.

From the South:

I-95 North to Route 202 North. Continue to exit for Route 401. Turn Left off of exit ramp onto Route 401 West. Continue to Route 113 North. Turn Right onto Route 113. Follow to Fairground entrance on Left, 1/4 mile past light at Coldstreams Road.

From the North:

Northeast Extension South to PA Turnpike Exit 326 (Valley Forge). Go through toll plaza and take first exit on right (Valley Forge). Follow to Route 23 (approx 4 lights). Route 23 West through Valley Forge Park and Phoenixville. Left on Route 113 South (McDonalds on Right). Follow approximately 1.5 miles, Fairgrounds are on the right.
